

and Parks (1994) describe the teaching of thinking through different subjects as 'infusion'. They claim that the infusion approach improves pupils' thinking as well as enhances the learning of any content.

Drama can be easily used as an appreciative inquiry tool in the educational context. In drama we work at our best, we dream, design and create new worlds.
