However, this approach should not be expected to be appropriate for every subject and every lesson because the subjects of projects may not be interesting for students, they may not be appropriate to the objectives of lessons, or some students may not be good at group work. Besides, we should never forget that the teachers who implement the PBL approach should work in cooperation. We can indicate individuals that contemporary education systems aim at only with the use of studies carried out considering all the variables stated above (those who are willing to do research, can solve problems, have critical thinking skills and can work in groups, etc.)

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
